<u><i>My BackPack Products/Services</i></u>	<u><i>Product/Services Description</i></u>
<b>Student/Parent Community</b>	Includes information on all students currently enrolled or enrolled for the fall. Students have online access to their class schedules, grades and comments, current report card, current year attendance, course catalog, requested courses, scheduled weekend leaves, course syllabus, homework assignments, debit account balances, clubs and activities. Parents have access to teachers, grades, attendance, current account balances, credit card payments, statement history, and donations.
<b>Online Inquiry/Application</b>	Automates your admissions process by streamlining procedures in a safe, secure web-based application. Customized with your school's branding, inquiries and applicants enter their data online and have it sent directly to the database via an approval process. Applicants can also view the status of their application requirements which are continually updated from our Admissions module. The information is seamlessly integrated and stored real-time in our Senior Systems database. Payments can be conveniently made online by credit card.
<b>Enrollment/Re-enrollment</b>	Processes enrollment and re-enrollment forms in real time online. Tracks enrollment/re-enrollment process online with quick glance icons. Easy to read quick view table shows pending actions. Sibling information linked automatically. Family histories are pre-populated for easier updating. <b>WEB SERVICES</b>	The Senior Web Services are a set of API's that will allow third-party application developers to get information from and post information to the Senior Systems Database. This will allow schools to create sophisticated portals where the users can see and update the latest information stored in the Senior Systems Database. The Web Services will provide information regarding constituents, students, parents and faculty while allowing the update of the biographical and address information. In addition, in order to help ensure the security of the disseminated information, any third-party application developer will be required to sign an agreement with Senior Systems acknowledging the confidentiality and proprietorship of the data.
<b>WEB HOSTING</b>	The Senior Systems Hosted Solution uses Citrix Presentation Server technology to host applications and facilitate a secure user experience. All data is transmitted via a secure SSL VPN gateway from our Oracle database servers to the end-user's desktop over the internet. No data is transmitted to local workstations without explicit permission from the end-user. The Senior Systems My BackPack portion of the hosted solution provides the same secure login using a VeriSign Secured SSL Certificate for data transmission across the internet. Our servers are located in the secure Senior Systems Hosted Solution Center, which is only card accessible by essential personnel. Data backups are performed at regular intervals and stored on tape-based media locally and transmitted to a secure remote data center.

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
